














Domestic Visitors by City, Q4 2019














Domestic Spending: 2019/2018 % Change by Quarter


























International Visitors: 2019/2018 % Change by Quarter














Oxnard International Spending by Quarter, 2019




International Spending: 2019/2018 % Change by Quarter


Ventura International Spending by Quarter, 2019




